

Information sheet VII Campament de músiques 2025

1. Presentation of the organizing entity

This year the team will be made up of Pau, Ana, Lidia, Rosa, Manos, Xico, Sara, Bea, Julio, Maria, Miquel, Ash, Diogo, Naiara and some more surprises. As of today, Pau, Irene, Rosa, Xico and Agnès are members. This is the seventh year that we have organized a summer activity as the Taller de Músiques association; a non-profit association with which we want to offer leisure and free time activities with music and the arts.

Before, we also had seven students, monitors, teachers and even directors with the Taller de Flute Dolça Aubarca, references on our island in services to youth since 1996. Our philosophy remains the same: to bring the musical and artistic experience closer to the children and young people of the Pitiüses. This is our website, and here is the Instagram. Between the association and other volunteers, we are a team of teachers and monitors with experience in the field of formal and non-formal artistic education, and we are very excited about the sixth edition of this project in which we want to bring together artistic practice, with contact with nature in an environment of coexistence, both in Es Cubells, and in Sant Francesc de Formentera. In addition, we share our past experiences with our training, and with other people who develop projects of different types. This year Ash will accompany us as an internship monitor.

3. Facilities and surroundings

The activities will take place at the <u>Centre d'espiritualitat Santa Teresa</u> in July and early August, and at the Sant Francesc <u>Hostel</u> and <u>Music School</u> in August. In addition, we will take advantage of the natural surroundings that surround the facilities to carry out different excursions.

4. Responsibilities and contact

As every year, insurance is maintained with Catalana-Occidente SA, to cover accidents and civil liability for the activity. The respective policies are T-04214447 and T-04200474.

If you do not book full board, you can book separate nights. The only problem is that we cannot guarantee that there will be places left.

6. Material for the Camp

We recommend that the participant prepares the backpack with the assistance of their parents, so that they know what they are carrying in the backpack and can identify what is theirs, in addition to learning how to pack the backpack to go camping.

Clothes and shoes:

- Comfortable clothes for activities. A change of clothes for each day plus a spare.
- (We will have soap if the clothes do not arrive for the days that are due)
- Sports shoes and socks
- Flip-flops that can get wet for the shower and it is better if they cover the whole

foot.

- Comfortable sandals
- Pajamas
- Swimsuit
- Jacket for the nights
- Bag for dirty clothes

Personal cleaning

- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Brush or comb
- Soap
- Shower towel

Others

- Cloth bag with 2 glasses, plate, cutlery and napkin. It is better that it is made of materials that do not break and that all the pieces bear the participant's name.
- Sheet, blanket and pillowcase, or sleeping bag.



- Sunscreen.
- Insect repellent
- Hat

They must not bring

Valuables, music players, electronic games, mobile phones, money, or food or drinks.

10. Group of parents

11. Payments and discounts

When making the payment it is important that you indicate the child's name and surname. Remember that we have 4 types of discounts:



10% "Early Bird" (start of registrations).

10% for the brother or sister of another participant.

10% for each extra activity you sign up for.

10% for single-parent families.

10% Any type of functional diversity.

5% for residents of Sant Josep (only valid at the camps in Es Cubells).

5% for residents of Formentera (only valid at the camp in Formentera).

If more than one discount is accumulated, the largest will be counted and the next will always be 5%. For example: Early Bird + Participant's sibling + Resident of Sant Josep will be applied as follows: 10%+5%+5%. That is, 20% in total.

The Music Workshop reserves funds for families with financial difficulties. No explanation is required, simply call us and we will reach an agreement in exchange for, for example, volunteering or participation of some kind.

In addition, the Music Workshop allocates a portion of the profits to provide wider discounts if someone could not access the activity due to their financial situation. No explanation will be required.
